

Turn Off iPad Notifications

Purpose

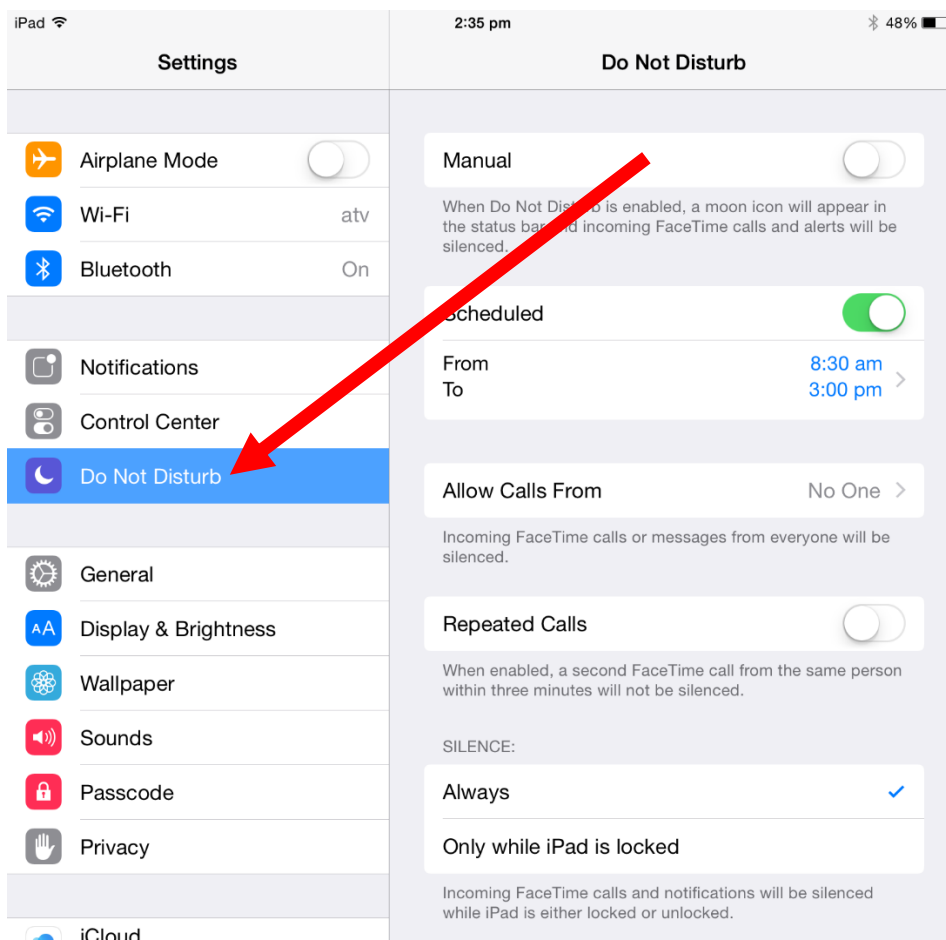
The following tutorial will show you how to turn off iPad notifications. These settings are required so you are not distracted during class while working on your iPad. Your teacher may require the Do Not Disturb setting to be turned off as a part of your class. These settings only have to be activated once, then the iPad will automatically take care of notifications, which will automatically turn back on outside school hours.

How to set up

1. Go to the Settings app on your iPad

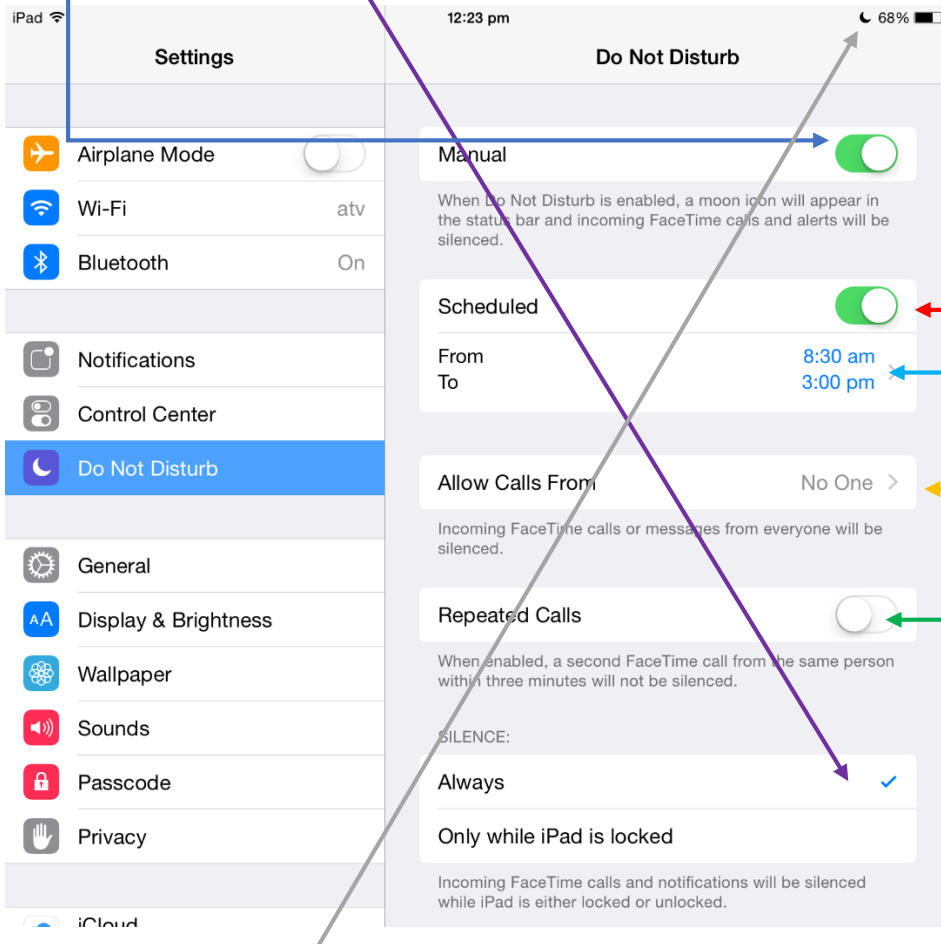


2. In Settings find "Do Not Disturb"



3. Change the settings under Do Not Disturb to the following:

- a. Turn on Manual (manually activates Do Not Disturb instead of waiting for the timer)
- b. Turn on Scheduled
- c. Set the time From 8:30am to 3:00pm
- d. 'Allow Calls from' No One
- e. 'Repeated Calls' set to off
- f. In the Silence Section - Check 'Always' (as the iPad can be used and no notifications will come through).



You will notice at the top of the iPad a crescent moon indicating that Do Not Disturb is now active.

If your iPad is not up to date, go to the Settings App, under Notifications and turn off all notifications there.
